In Geography, we will be comparing the human and physical features of our local areas. We will be comparing Cosham to Titchfield.

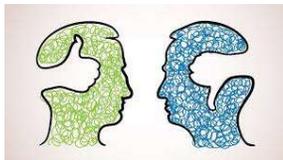
Physical Education

We will be looking at what symbols mean to us. We will then look at how the cross is used as a symbol by Christians at Easter.



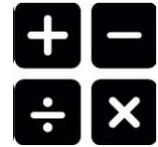
English

Maths

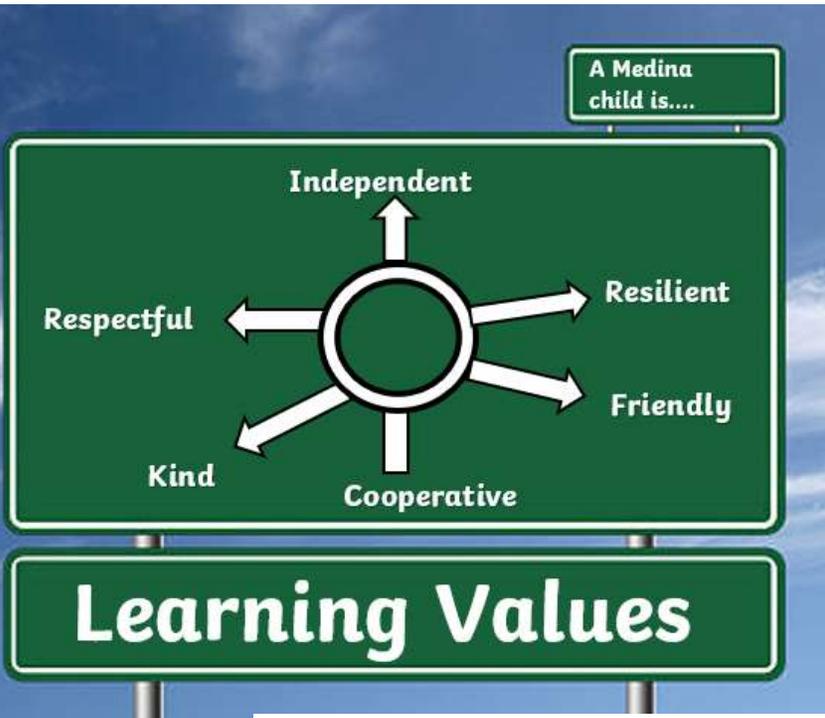
Our maths lessons this half term will focus on developing our fluency multiplying and dividing. We will look at mental methods and using written methods with larger numbers.
