

Science-forces

We will be exploring forces such as gravity, air resistance and buoyancy. We will be learning about how these forces are used by aeroplanes, boats and parachutes.



RE

In RE we will be learning about rituals around the home, school and in different religions.

Maths

In maths we will learn about

- mixed numbers
- improper fractions
- adding and subtracting fractions
- reading, writing and comparing graphs, pie charts and tally charts.



Art

In art we will be sketching portraits of Tudor kings and queens. We will also be creating collage portraits.

English

We will be learning about The Witches by Roald Dahl. We will be using it to create roleplays, character description and to aid story writing. We will be focussing on creating atmosphere and including a range of sentence structures in our writing.
