

## Ancient Greeks



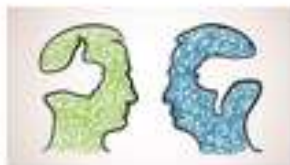
In History we will be looking at how the Ancient Greeks helped civilisation. We will look at the food they provided, how they contributed to language and we will look at how the Olympics began.

In English, we will be reading descriptions of mythical creatures and using these to inspire our own writing.

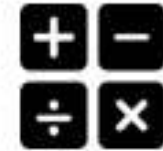

## Maths



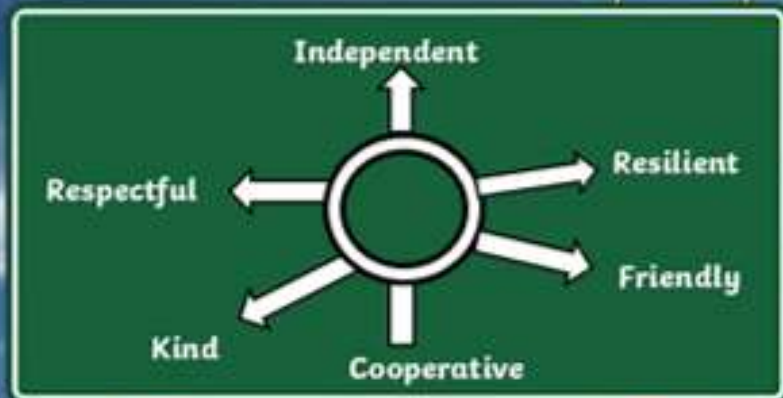
Our maths lessons this half term will focus on developing our fluency adding and subtracting numbers. We will look at mental methods and using written methods with larger numbers.
