English:



We will be basing our writing on Sport. During the first few weeks, we are going to create our own sports by merging two sports together. We will be working to improve our use of conjunctions, paragraphs and headings and subheadings.

Maths:



In maths, we will be learning about fractions. We will be working out how to find fractions of amounts and how to identify which fractions show the same amounts.

Geography:

We are going to be comparing Italy to the United Kingdom. We will look at the type of buildings and how the land is used.



Art:

In art, we will be studying the work of an artist called Matisse. We will be creating our own 3D model using ideas from his work.

Science:

We will be learning about states of matter. We will be investigating solids, liquids and gases. We will even be making our own ice-cream





P.E. days:

Homework:
