Maths: <ul style="list-style-type: none">We will be learning how to read, write order and compare numbers up to 1 000,000.We will be learning how to multiply and divide numbers that include decimals.We will be learning how to read and write fractions as decimals.We will be learning how to read, write and compare numbers up to three decimal places.We will be learning how to convert between millimetres, centimetres and meters.	Science <ul style="list-style-type: none">We will be learning about earth and space.We will be learning about the planets and how they move.We will be learning about day and night.
		Geography: <p>We will be looking at the importance of water in the world.</p>
