English: <ul style="list-style-type: none">We will be studying Shakespeare and in particular looking at Macbeth and Romeo and Juliet.We will read a selection of short stories and learning to write summaries and making predictions. 	Maths: <ul style="list-style-type: none">We will be learning to recall and use multiplication and division facts up to 12x12.We are learning to understand and use decimal numbers, including multiplying and dividing.We will be reading and using different measurements and making comparisons.We will also use written and mental methods to add and subtract numbers.	Science <ul style="list-style-type: none">We will be learning to classify living things.We will be learning about Carl Linnaen.
		Geography: <p>We will be looking at different volcanoes around the world.</p>
		Art: <p>We will be looking at George Seurat's art work and then recreating our own pictures using pointillism.</p>
		RE: <p>We will be exploring - 'What is faith?'</p>
