My topic this half-term is:

All about me

I am going to be learning about:

- The rules and routines of the classroom, and finding my way around the school.
- How to organise myself and my things at the beginning and end of the day.
- Making new friends and beginning to build good relationships with different adults in school.
- Counting, reading and ordering numbers to 10 and beyond.
- Learning to recognise and write many letter sounds as part of our daily 'Read Write Inc' sessions.

You could help me by:

- Encouraging me to dress each day on my own, especially managing buttons, zips and jumpers
- Helping me to learn the names of the adults and children in my class/ school
- Encouraging me to draw and write at home
- Sharing a bedtime story each night

My targets for this half term are:

Phonics	To learn all the routines and expectations for our daily phonics sessions - 'Read Write Inc'.
Reading	To develop a good routine of practising my reading book at home every day. To be able to talk about the pictures in my book, and to retell the story in my own words using complete sentences and story vocabulary.
Number	To be able to accurately count a set of objects- first to 10, and then amounts beyond. To be able to read numbers around me, such as house numbers, page numbers and road signs.
Emotional Development	To be able to talk to my family about the things I have been learning at school. To be able to talk to someone if I am worried about something, and to have the confidence to ask questions if I am unsure.

Some activities/suggestions to help me reach my targets:

Read my reading books and write a comment book in my reading record book
Practice my letter sounds and letter formation every night
Ask me to count out objects at home
Point out numbers when we are out and about
Ask me every day about what I have been learning about in school
