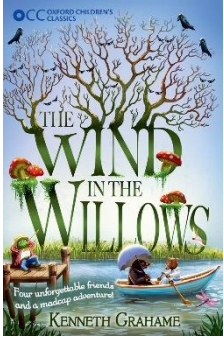


## English

## Maths

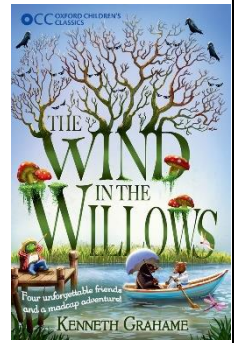

## Topic
