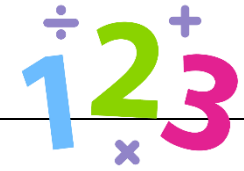


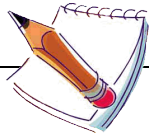
Year 6's Spring 1 topic is:

Crime and Punishment



English:

We will be reading *The Boy at the Back of the Class* by Onjali Q. Raúf. We will be writing a short narrative piece about playground events using dialogue.



History:

We are going to be looking at crime and punishment. We will learn about how crime and punishment has changed over time in Britain.

Our vocabulary this half term is: treason, execution, betrayal, torture, justice, committed, summoned, consequence.

French:

In French, we will be learning how to talk about the weather and different hobbies.

We will practise the sounds: u, je, ch, er, ain, qu & ille.



Homework:

Spellings are given out on a Monday and are tested the following Monday.

Maths homework will be set on a Wednesday and is due back in school on Monday. This will be on Google Classroom.

Children should be reading at home every day. Their reading diary should be filled in each time they read.
