

## Year 3 Learning Together Spring 2



### English

To begin this half term, we will focus on poetry. We will read poems by Allan Ahlberg from his collection 'Please Mrs Butler' and then create our own in his style. Then, we will focus on 'Bill's New Frock' by Anne Fine and learn about plot and narrative within a story. We will have a **spelling test every Monday**. **New spellings are given out on Monday each week.**

### Science – I wonder...

This half term is based on scientific enquiry, allowing the children to develop their scientific skills and their curiosity of the world. We will design and implement experiments to test different hypotheses.



### Art

We will research artist Geoffrey Teece and consider his fine line drawings and use of watercolour. Influenced by his style, we will create drawings of areas around Titchfield before finishing them in watercolours.

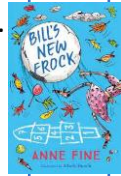
### DT

Our focus will be textiles and we will design a felt pencil case to use in school.

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### Topic – South-East Region

Our topic this half term is geography based. We will learn about the surrounding and home counties. We will also compare the human and physical geography of Cosham with neighbouring town, Titchfield. We will use maps and atlases throughout this topic. Our key vocabulary is: Counties, compare, village, residential, rural, area, attractions, centre, regions and sketch map.



### PSHE

We will learn about respectful behaviour and the importance of self-respect. We will also think about how to stay safe online.

### French

We will learn French numbers up to 20 and use this to ask and answer our age in French. We will learn the days of the week and the names of the months and combine this with our learning on French numbers to discuss our birthdays. We will also learn how to say different colours in French.



### Maths

In this half term, we will learn fractions. We will learn what fractions are, the correct names of fractions and how we can work out fractions of amounts. Children should practice their timetables at home on **TT Rockstars**.

### PE

On Wednesdays with Mr Murphy, the children will be learning tennis skills and net and wall. As a class on Tuesdays, we will continue our Real PE sessions, developing our coordination and skills.

### RE

This half term we will learn about the symbol of the cross in Christianity.

Reading diaries will be collected on Friday and checked. Rewards for regular reading will be given out on Monday. **Spellings** and **timetables** can be practiced at home.
